Our CPP30115 Certificate III in Urban Pest Management has been designed for Pest Technicians who are required to identify general and timber urban pests, assess pest problems, consider pest management options, develop pest management plans, liaise with customers and implement pest management strategies. In most cases, the technician will work alone and have responsibility for managing chemicals and equipment used in pest management as well as for a pest management vehicle, including the vehicle storage area.

Successful completion of this course students will have the ability to comprehensively apply their knowledge and skill across the operations of the pest business for growth. With their certification, students may apply to their state licensing authority for pest technician and timber licensing.
