

Pest Technician Course

Our Pest Technician course has been designed to deliver the required training for trainee Pest Technicians to achieve their Pest Technician license. In this course students will build knowledge on skills to operate competently and safely as to:

- ❖ Identify urban general pests
- ❖ Assess infestation, cause & severity
- ❖ Develop & communicate management plans
- ❖ Select & maintain equipment and materials
- ❖ Complete applications using appropriate equipment

Units of Competency

- ❖ CPPPMT3005 Manage pests without applying pesticides
- ❖ CPPPMT3006 Manage pests by applying pesticides
- ❖ CPPPMT3018 Maintain equipment and pesticide storage area in pest management vehicles



Course Entry

Our standard entry requirements include a Unique Student Identifier (USI) number, and a Language Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment (if deemed required).

Work Placement: To ensure our students can apply their training in an industry environment, Rapid Training requires all students to either be **employed** or have **pre-arranged & documented work placement***, under an accredited technician. During the placement the student must complete a logbook of 25 General Pest inspections & applications.

*The [Work Placement Agreement form](#), signed by the accredited technician, must be submitted during enrolment to confirm work placement.

Course Outcomes

Students will be issued a Statement of Attainment for completed units of competency.

Prior to enrolment and upon completion, please consult your state's [licencing authority](#) on their Pest Technician Licensing license requirements.
