

# CPP30119 Certificate III in Urban Pest Management



This course has been designed to deliver the competencies for trainee Pest Technicians to achieve their <u>General & Timber Pest</u> <u>Control licenses</u>, with potential access to federal Traineeship incentives.

This qualification is only offered through online and correspondence delivery methods, whilst under the supervision of licensed/accredited Pest Technician.

In this course students will build knowledge on skills to operate competently and safely as to:

- Identify urban general and timber pests
- Assess infestation, cause & severity
- ❖ Develop & communicate management plans with clients
- Select, maintain & manage equipment and materials
- Complete applications using appropriate equipment and methods, in line with industry standards.

- CPPUPM3018 Maintain equipment and pesticide storage area in pest management vehicles

- CPPUPM3017 Maintain, service and repair pest management equipment

All units are assessed online, and methods include:

- Theory Assessment: Students are required to complete a range of Multiple-Choice questions, Short Answer questions, Case Study & Scenario Based Assignments on the course lessons
- Practical Video Assessments: Student are required to record a range of videos demonstrating their ability competently apply their skills and knowledge across three live sites
- Project Assignments: Student are required to apply their skills and knowledge to a range of project assignments covering key tasks performed by technicians e.g., resource research, scheduling
- **Logbooks:** Student must complete the following logbooks under an accredited technician:
  - <u>10 General Pest Inspections</u> & <u>Treatments</u> (CPPUPM3005 & CPPUPM3006).
  - <u>10 Timber Pest Inspections</u> (CPPUPM3008).
  - <u>10 Timber Pest Treatments (chemical)</u> (CPPUPM3010).

# **COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

- USI: A Unique Student Identifier (USI) number
- **LLN**: A Language Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) assessment (if deemed required).
- Employment: To ensure students can apply their training in an industry environment, all enrolling students must either be:
  - Employed in the pest control industry or
  - **Engage** a qualified technician to supervise and document **work placement**\*. \*The <u>Work Placement Agreement form</u>, signed by the qualified technician, must be submitted within the enrolment application.

Successful completion of this course students will have the ability to comprehensively apply their knowledge and skill across the operations of the pest business for growth.

Students will be issued a nationally recognised **Certificate** upon completion of the course, and upon request, a **Statement of Attainment** for completed units of competency once licencing units are achieved.
